CONDUCT OF CANDIDATURE SEMINARS

(1) **Proposal Defence**

(a) **Presentation Period**

- Master and doctoral candidates by research are required to present the Proposal Defence not later than the second semester.
- (ii) Master and doctoral candidates by mixed mode are required to present the Proposal Defence not later than the third semester.
- (iii) Doctoral candidates by coursework and clinical coursework are required to present Proposal Defence in the first semester, which candidates register for the research component.

(b) Submission of the Research Proposal Report

Candidates are required to submit four (4) copies of complete research proposal report with 3000-7000 words to the Postgraduate Office not later than two (2) weeks before the date of the presentation, which includes the following:

- (i) Introduction, statement of problem and scope of research;
- (ii) Research objectives;
- (iii) Summary of literature review;
- (iv) Description of conceptual framework or summary of experimental methods or summary of research design and required equipment.
- (v) The importance and relevance of the study;
- (vi) Preliminary findings / Pilot test (initial findings, if any)
- (vii) Proposed work schedule based on the designated date of submission of thesis / dissertation; and
- (viii) Brief bibliography.

(2) Confirmation Defence (for Fast Track Entry [Accelerated Admission] Candidates)

(a) **Presentation Period**

Doctoral by Research candidates through Fast Track Entry (Accelerated Admission) are required to present Confirmation Defence not later than the third semester.

(b) Submission of Confirmed Proposed Research Report

Candidates are required to submit four (4) copies of complete research proposal report with 4,000-7000 words to the Postgraduate Office not later than two (2) weeks before the date of the presentation, which includes the following:

- (i) Introduction, statement of problem and scope of research;
- (ii) Research objectives;
- (iii) Complete literature review;
- (iv) Solid research methods;
- (v) The importance and relevance of the study;
- (vi) Preliminary findings / Pilot test (initial findings, if any);
- (vii) Proposed work schedule based on the designated date of submission of thesis / dissertation; and
- (viii) Brief bibliography

(3) Candidature Defence

(a) Presentation period

- Master candidates by research are required to present Candidature
 Defence not later than the third semester.
- Doctoral candidates by research are required to present Candidature Defence not later than the fifth semester.
- (iii) Doctoral candidates by coursework, clinical coursework and mixed mode are required to present Candidature Defence set by the Faculty not later than the sixth semester.

(iv) Master candidates by mixed mode are required to present Candidature Defence set by the Faculty not later than the fourth semester.

(b) Submission of Progress Report

Candidates are required to submit four (4) copies of complete research progress report with 5000-10000 words to the Postgraduate Office not later than two (2) weeks before the date of presentation, which includes the following:

- (i) Abstract (500 words in Bahasa Malaysia and English);
- (ii) Objectives and statement of problem;
- (iii) The importance and relevance of the study;
- (iv) Brief and concise literature review;
- (v) Solid research methods;
- (vi) Research results obtained so far;
- (vii) Brief bibliography;
- (viii) Research plan that leads to the submission of the dissertation / thesis on the designated date; and
- (ix) List of publications or conference papers presented during the period of candidature, if any.

(4) Thesis Seminar

(a) Presentation period

Doctoral candidates by research are required to present Thesis Seminar or equivalent before submission of thesis for examination.

(b) Submission of summary of thesis

Candidates are required to submit presentation notes with abstract to the Postgraduate Office not later than three (3) working days before the presentation date.
