# Remember

#### **P1** Registration

- 1. Your responsibility to find a suitable **supervisor** from our Faculty (any department). Refer to the faculty website for lecturers' profiles.
- 2. Prepare a ONE-PAGE research intent. Focus on problem statement & background, clear objectives and methodology (show components related to Data Science clearly). Submit the topic registration form (available on our website) along with Research Intent to the Admin Office (i.e. first two weeks of the semester).
- 3. Meet your supervisor regularly
- 4. Deliver proposal presentation (10%) with supervisor and internal examiner. Remind your supervisor, if need be. Your supervisor will make the arrangement.

#### **P2** Registration

- 1. Meet your supervisor regularly
- Pay attention to plagiarism and word count.
- 3. Submit research report early (refer to timeline once updated). No extensions allowed. All report submission forms are available on our website.
- 4. Wait for results (similar to all the other courses, announced after the board meeting)
- 5. Students who FAIL research project, MUST repeat P1 and P2 again.

- (1) The number of words is calculated for the main text only (chapters 1 through the last chapter), including tables and footnotes, but excludes attachments, references, pictures and diagrams.
- (2) With the support of the supervisor, the candidate may apply to the Faculty (certified by JKIT) to submit a thesis/ dissertation/ research project that does not meet the minimum of words for examination, subject to a minimum number of words not exceeding 10%
- (3) This regulation will apply to all postgraduate candidates and will be effective from session 2019/2020
