## Practice Makes Preparedness FCSIT Conducts Full-Scale Evacuation Drill

In line with Universiti Malaya's commitment to ensuring a safe and responsive campus, the Faculty of Computer Science and Information Technology (FSKTM) successfully conducted a comprehensive evacuation drill involving all staff, students, and visitors. The evacuation drill was conducted on 26 Februari 2025 at 9:00 AM, throughout the FSKTM Building, encompassing Block A & Block B, Universiti Malaya.

This exercise involved the full participation of academic staff, administrative and technical personnel, as well as students who were present on the premises during the drill. The drill

was coordinated by the FSKTM Occupational Safety and Health Committee (JKKP FSKTM), with strategic support from the following agencies:

- Fire and Rescue Department of Malaysia (BOMBA), Pantai Dalam
- Occupational Safety and Health Office, Universiti Malaya (OSHE UM)

Additional safety demonstrations were conducted as part of the drill, which included a practical briefing on the proper handling and operation of fire extinguishers. Participants were also briefed on the correct procedures upon reaching designated assembly points, including headcounts, reporting protocols, and maintaining clear communication with emergency response personnel. These demonstrations aimed to enhance practical knowledge and reinforce correct safety behavior during actual emergency situations.
