## FCSIT UG Students Make Their Mark at UM UG IFEST!

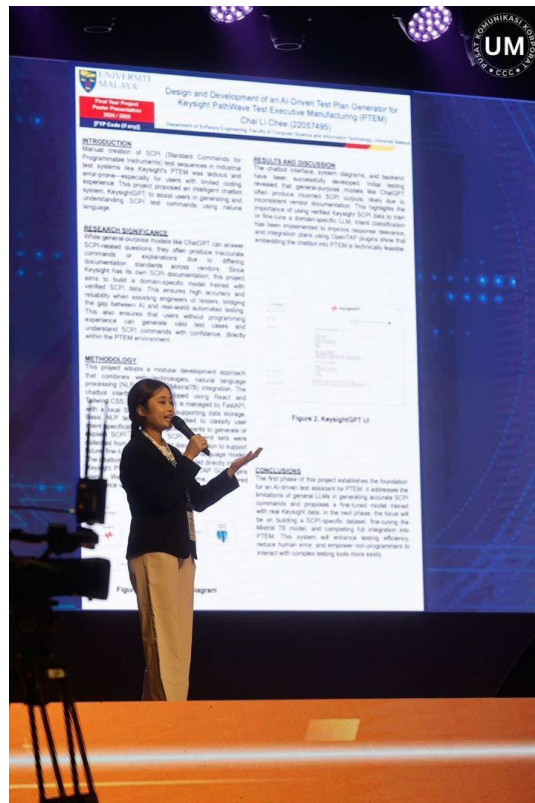
